Ashover Parish Council has been in discussion regarding the possibility of siting a large mast on the hard courts/playing field on Milken Lane, Ashover.

Your Parish Council has been in discussion with 'Shared Access' of Navigation House, The Shipyard, Bath Road, Lymington, Hampshire over the possible erection of a large mast immediately adjacent the hard courts on Milken Lane, Ashover, in order to improve mobile phone connectivity in the area. If approved, your Parish Council would benefit from a large cash payment. However, Councillors are aware that residents hold major concerns with regard to impact on the surrounding countryside and health issues in relation to mobile phone masts. The mast would most likely take the form of a 'Shrouded Pole' with associated electronic communications apparatus similar to that shown below. Even if Ashover Parish Council agreed to the proposal, it would all be subject to Planning Permission

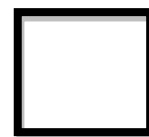
