We're so lucky in Derbyshire to have to some of Britain's most loved countryside spots. But we quite often don't make the most of what's on our doorstep.

That's definitely true of Ashover Rock, Eddlestow Lot and Highoredish. These hidden gems have been enjoyed by local families for generations but lots of people in the county have never visited.

The well-loved places with stunning views have now been made into local nature reserves. This means we'll now be able to protect and enhance the features that make these sites important for local people and wildlife.

The sites are in Ashover Parish and we look after them with volunteers and organisations such as Bolsover Woodlands Enterprise and Derbyshire
