NEIGHBOURHOOD PLAN FOR ASHOVER PARISH –

The neighbourhood plan was progressing along the lines we had planned. However, Historic England have made some comments relating to the Strategic Environment Assessment and one of our recommended sites. After consultation with our consultants, *Yourlocale*, it was decided that we would temporarily withdraw the plan, remove the site in question, then resubmit the plan to statutory consultees and residents for a six week consultation period. This six week period starts on 31 January 2017 and the closing date for comments will be 13 March 2017.
