NEIGHBOURHOOD PLAN FOR ASHOVER PARISH and TRAFFIC SURVEY

Following consideration at the March meeting, Ashover Parish Council has given its approval for the work undertaken by the Neighbourhood plan steering group. The plan is now acknowledged as the Draft Neighbourhood Plan for the Parish of Ashover. This document, following the withdrawal of the NEDDC draft local plan, is now the only planning policy framework document in place for our parish. This document has been produced following public consultation with all households and drop in events held in the Parish Hall and we thank all who contributed to these consultations. The next steps for the plan will be for it to be submitted to North East Derbyshire District Council for specific approval, it then goes off to a Government Inspector who will scrutinize it, once that approval is obtained then the plan will be circulated to all the households in the parish. A referendum will then be held to hopefully gain the approval of the parishioners. It will then be considered fit for purpose and become the made document for the parish of Ashover.

NEW DEFIBRILLATOR

Your Parish Council has installed the first defibrillator at Uppertown, with grant funding provided by Ashover Medical Centre Ltd. **IN AN EMERGENCY, DIAL 999 AND YOU WILL BE GIVEN THE CODE TO THE CABINET AND FURTHER INSTRUCTIONS.** It is intended that further defibrillators will be provided around the parish including sites at Ashover, Milltown, Kelstedge, Littlemoor and Alton.
